The disposal of end-of-life IT and consumer electronics is a complex problem. Ever-tightening government regulations and the legal liability for complete removal of sensitive data prior to disposal require specific skills and technology. You can't just truck your e-waste to a landfill—and you would never want to! The hazardous materials found in e-waste such as cadmium, mercury, and lead wreak havoc with the environment. And the problem of e-waste is large and growing. In 2008, EPA completed a study showing that of the 2.25 million tons of televisions, cell phones and computer products ready for end-of-life management, only 18% (414,000 tons) were collected for recycling and 82% (1.84 million tons) were disposed of, primarily in landfills. Further, EPA estimated that approximately 235 million units sold between 1980 and 2007 were obsolete and in storage, awaiting some method of end-of-life management. When you factor in the real estate, taxes, and depreciation—those idled assets in storage are costing you money!
